RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO BLACK WALL STREET IN SUPPORT OF THEIR MISSION TO PROVIDE RESOURCES AND SERVICES TO BLACK AND UNDER-SERVED COMMUNITIES TO INCREASE THEIR SELF-SUFFICIENCY, SELF-ESTEEM, AND SELF-WORTH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000. (GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Black Wall Street, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, is a community resource and youth center formed to meet the needs of black and other underserved minorities in the Reno/Sparks area; and,

WHEREAS, Black Wall Street, works to create and sustain a strong support system to promote literacy, education programs, and resources for all ages; and

WHEREAS, Black Wall Street, has collaborated with other outreach programs to host events to provide schools supplies, clothing, and other goods to community children in need; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Duerr in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Black Wall Street; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
