To Reno City Council, Airport Authority, FAA

The past 3 years I've tried to get this issue on the Agenda for the City Council and Airport Authority. Now I'm told I had to send the information to this address.

I've been dealing with the FAA, who supposedly took over airspace of Reno in 2002. In 1980 I moved into the EMERGENCY RUNWAYS for light aircraft and discovered planes were landing all over in this sector. I called the Reno Airport Authority and asked them WHY they were landing/taking off out of an EMERGENCY RUNWAY.

The traffic ended with ONE PHONE CALL. Then in 2002 I noticed light aircraft encroaching on our airspace again. It was light at first, then over the years it started happening more and more. I called the Airport Authority who said the FAA had taken over our airspaces.

For years now, they have harassed me by flying most ALL helicopters over my home and in the past 4 years more and more light aircraft have been flying, using the EAST/WEST RUNWAY, which again, with less population was ONLY AN EMERGENCY RUNWAY. They fly out at 5:30 a.m./6 a.m./etc.! This has been causing my sleeping cycle to be interrupted constantly, and the ANNOYING sounds of the planes are almost unbearable.

I know the history of EMERGENCY RUNWAY OVER THE PAST 60 yrs., and the Reno City Council denied the Airport from using the EAST/WEST runway except in emergencies. It was a time when Bill Raggio and many big contractors lived in the sector and probably had influence and clout. Now that they no longer live in this sector, I guess the Airport Authority, City Council, and now the FAA thinks they can just make citizens' lives unbearable at this time. I think NOT!

I'm so done with their making my life unbearable! Unfortunately, July 1st I broke my hip, so I've been pre-occupied, but today I've been woken up for umpteenth time by those light aircraft, and I'M NOT GOING TO TAKE IT ANYMORE.

I will be filing a 3-BILLION-dollar lawsuit on all of the factions mentioned in this email, as I've said this the past 4 yrs., but just found out that I had to send it to this address to get it to the City Council, Airport Authority, FAA. I've spoken with Ed Pierce of channel 8 over the past 2 years and he knows the truth of it and said to let him know if I file the lawsuit.

Richard Miller from the Airport Authority told me months ago that the people flying into Reno didn't want to have to drive from Stead or East of town to land! These were the proposals of the past 60 yrs., and TOO BAD! There is a huge increase of population now, and I am still in this sector fighting like David to Goliath! I will not be silenced, and this has got to be resolved outside of OUR, THE CITIZENS OF RENO'S airspace.

I look forward to a response, since when I last called the Airport Authority and told them I was looking at filing a lawsuit. THE PLANES STOPPED FLYING for over a week, then slowly started encroaching once again. I still have weeks of rehab on my hip, but trust me, if we don't get dialogue and resolve here, I will be filing that lawsuit.

As if constructing a high-density apartment building with insufficient parking and barely minimal setback from neighboring properties is not absurd enough, now the Reno City Council is proposing to convert the adjacent alley to Emergency Vehicle access?! What about the people who live along that alley and need access to their current parking spaces? What about trash pickup from those buildings, whose dumpsters line the so-called "Unnamed Alley"? What about people in the neighborhood who routinely walk and bike and drive through that alley? This plan just gets worse and worse.

The city already passed up an opportunity to put something lovely on that vacant lot, something that would have beautified the surroundings and benefited people living in the neighborhood and beyond. Why, I ask myself, has this city council dedicated itself to uglifying Reno and failing to care for the amenities that once made it a great place to live?

Making these kinds of drastic changes to our neighborhood will negatively affect the lives of many people. And for what? To accommodate the construction of a building too large for the lot and crowded with tiny, barely livable apartments—hardly anyone's idea of what home should be.

There comes a time when an idea needs to be reconsidered. It's not too late. I propose that our city council put aside its previous decision and rethink the best use of the vacant lot known as 0 Riverside Drive.

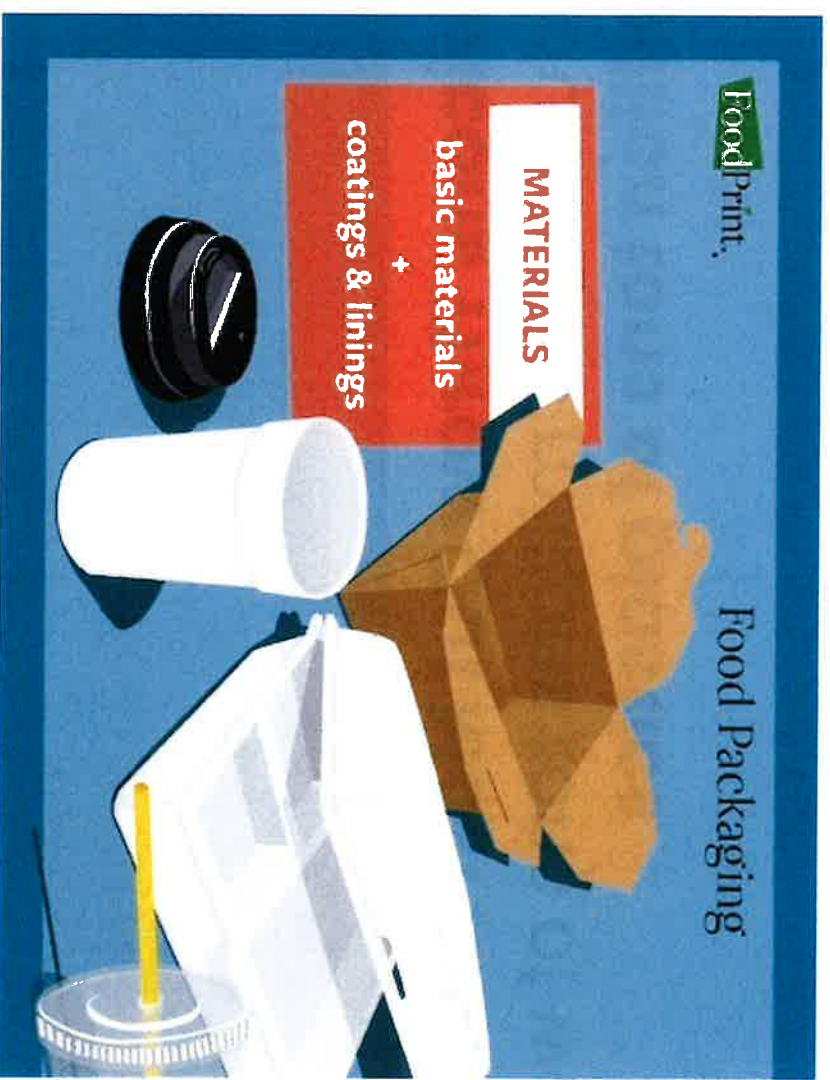

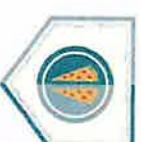

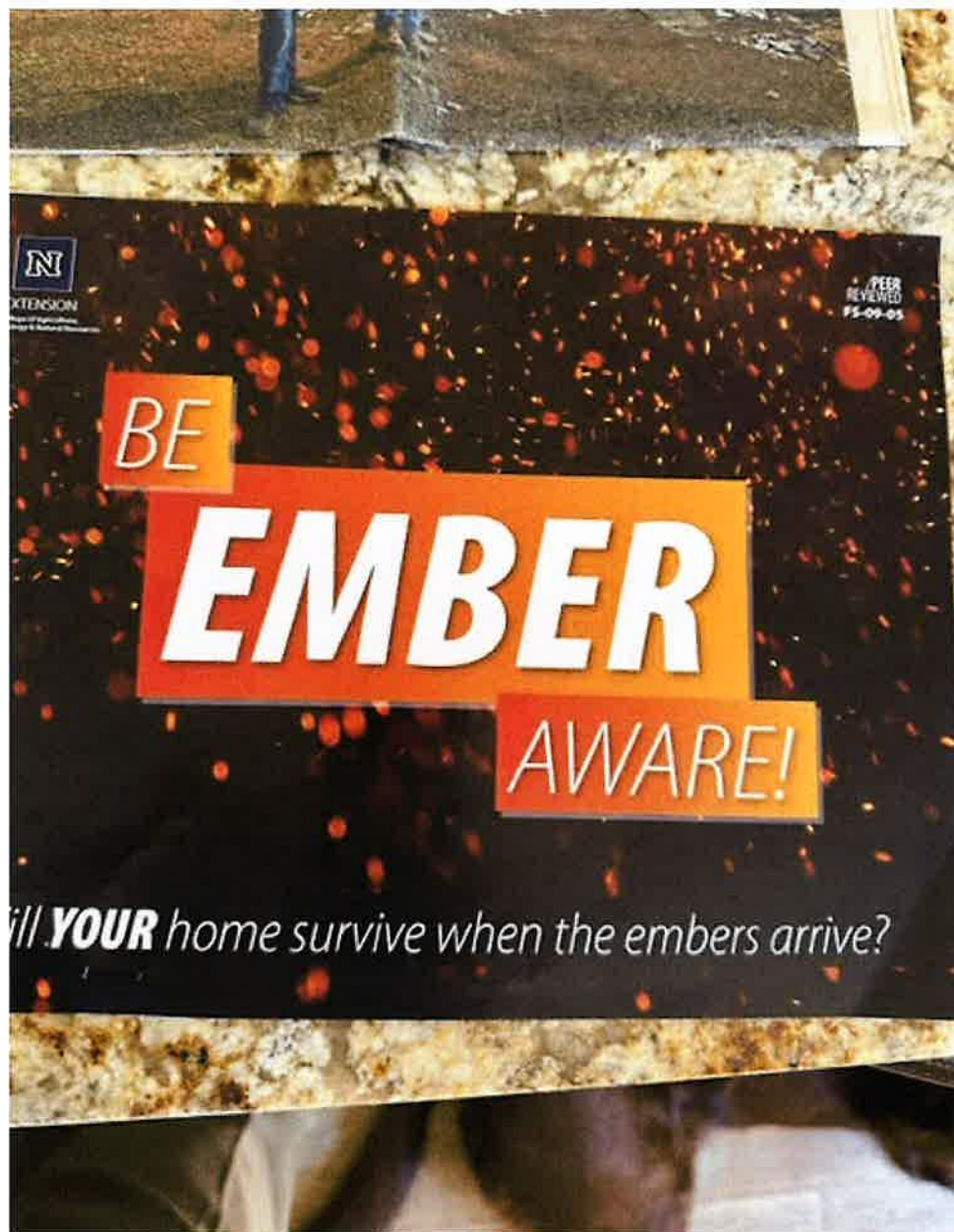
