RESOLUTION OF THE RENO CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING THE SALARY AND BENEFITS OF THE RENO MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV, SECTION 4.020(3) OF THE RENO CITY CHARTER, PROVIDING A SALARY INCREASE, AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION 9050, AND PROVIDING FOR OHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Reno City Charter, Article IV, Section 4.020(3) provides that the salaries of the Reno Municipal Court Judges shall be fixed by Resolution of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the salaries for the Reno Municipal Court Judges were last fixed in July 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Reno City Council desires to fix the annual salary for the Reno Municipal Court Judges at a figure ten percent (10%) above the top of the salary range for the Court Administrator, as such range may be amended from time to time by action of the Reno City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Reno City Council desires that this change be made retroactive to July 1, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reno City Council desires that the Reno Municipal Court Judges retain all other benefits they currently receive.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of Reno as follows:

- **Section 1**. The City Council hereby finds that the foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated by this reference.
  - **Section 2**. Resolution No. 9050 is hereby rescinded.
- **Section 3**. The annual salary for the position of Municipal Court Judge is hereby fixed at ten percent (10%) above the top of the salary range of the Court Administrator retroactively to July 1, 2023.
- **Section 4.** The intent of this resolution is that the salaries of the Municipal Court Judges shall hereafter be revised concurrently with that of the Court Administrator's salary range, as amended from time to time, without the necessity of separate action by the City Council.

The Municipal Court Judges shall continue to receive all other benefits they currently receive, including but not limited to retirement benefits, health insurance, vehicle allowance, mobile phone allowance, and other allowances consistent with those obtained by City of Reno elected officials.

**Section 5**. The Mayor, City Manager, members, officers, employees, and agents of the City are hereby authorized and directed, jointly and severally, to do any and all things

and to execute, deliver, and record all documents as may be required and otherwise to give effect to, carry out and comply with the terms and intent of this resolution, and to take all necessary and appropriate actions to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
