

**RESOLUTION TO REPEAL AND REPLACE  
RESOLUTION NO. 8838 BY CHANGING MEMBERSHIP  
REQUIREMENTS TO REMOVE SPECIFIC LANGUAGE  
LIMITING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF GENERAL  
PUBLIC MEMBERS, CHANGING RESIGNATION  
LANGUAGE TO APPLY TO THREE CONSECUTIVE  
MEETING ABSENCES, REMOVING RESTRICTIONS ON  
THE CHAIR SERVING MORE THAN ONE  
CONSECUTIVE TWO YEAR TERM, UPDATING  
DEPARTMENT NAME TO REFLECT “DEVELOPMENT  
SERVICES” AND MODIFYING THE CAPITALIZATION  
THROUGH THE RESOLUTION SO “BY-LAWS” IS ALL  
LOWERCASE.**

**WHEREAS,** the Reno City Council approved Resolution No. 6140 on February 18, 2003, creating the Building Enterprise Fund Advisory Committee; and

**WHEREAS,** the Reno City Council amended Resolution No. 6140 with Resolution No. 6377 on June 23, 2004, by changing the name of the Building Enterprise Fund Advisory Committee to the Planning and Building Enterprise Funds Advisory Committee and changing the number of members of the Committee from seven (7) to nine (9); and

**WHEREAS,** the City has created a Building Permit Enterprise Fund for the building permit process to provide user fees in the fiscal support of operations directly related to the building permit process; and

**WHEREAS,** the City has created an advisory committee to provide advice and counsel on the policies and management of the Building Permit Enterprise Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Reno City Council:

That Resolution No. 8838 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

**Section 1.** That the City shall appoint up to seven (7) members from the Reno community building industry representing a cross-section of the industry including residential, commercial and industrial. Members may also include a public officer or employee of the local government who manages the fiscal affairs of the local government and a public officer or employee of the local government who oversees directly the operation of the enterprise fund.

**Section 2.** Three consecutive meeting absences by a Committee member shall result in automatic resignation of that member. Such a resignation may be appealed to the Reno City Council. Said appeal shall be initiated by the member and filed with the Reno City Clerk.

**Section 3.** Updated department name updated to reflect “Development Services.”

**Section 4.** Modified the capitalization through the resolution so “by-laws” is all lowercase.

**Section 5.** The Mayor, City Manager, members, officers, employees and agents of the City are hereby authorized and directed, jointly and severally, to do any and all things as may be required and otherwise to give effect to, carry out and comply with the terms and intent of this Resolution, and to take all necessary and appropriate actions to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

**Section 6.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
