

Residential Parking Zones

- RNC 6.07
- Petition driven
- Need verified by City staff
- Vehicles cause congestion and burden
- Cannot be opposed by more than half of home owners
- City council has to approve





Proposed Residential Parking Zone Putnam



- Request from Property Owners on Putnam Dr.
- Code Enforcement Verified
 - 75% vehicles not residents in north east area
- Proposed Zone includes whole neighborhood





Parking Zone Pros and Cons

PROS

- Only residents of guests of residents displaying a parking pass can park on the street
- Guest passes available
- You can have purchase passes up to the number of bedrooms in your home

CONS

- More parking restrictions
- Parking passes cost \$26
 annually
- There is a limited number of spots available due to street space
 - 112 spaces for 56 properties



Putnam Parking Zone Survey Results

- 56 Property Owners
- 39 unique responses
- 79% Support
