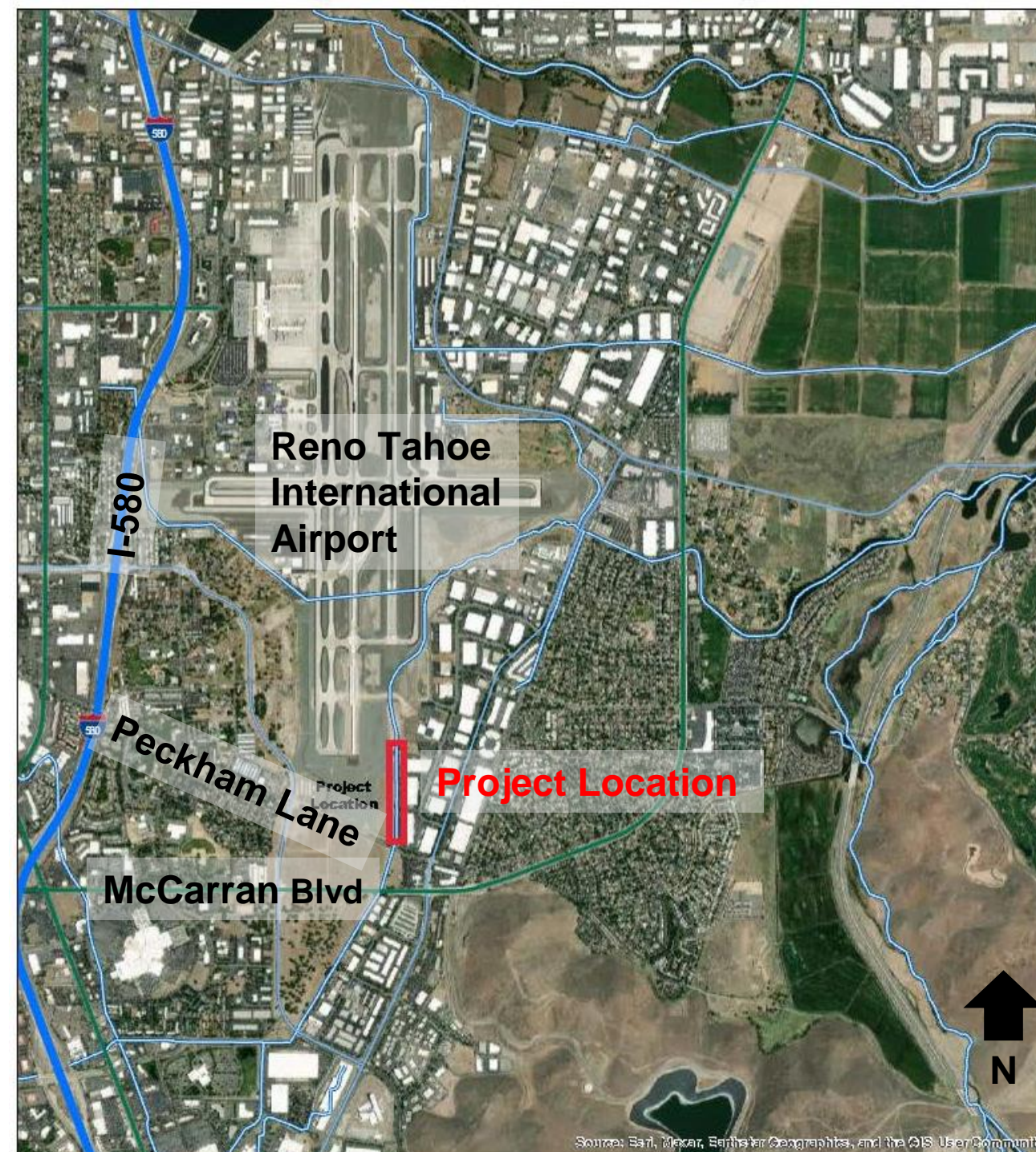

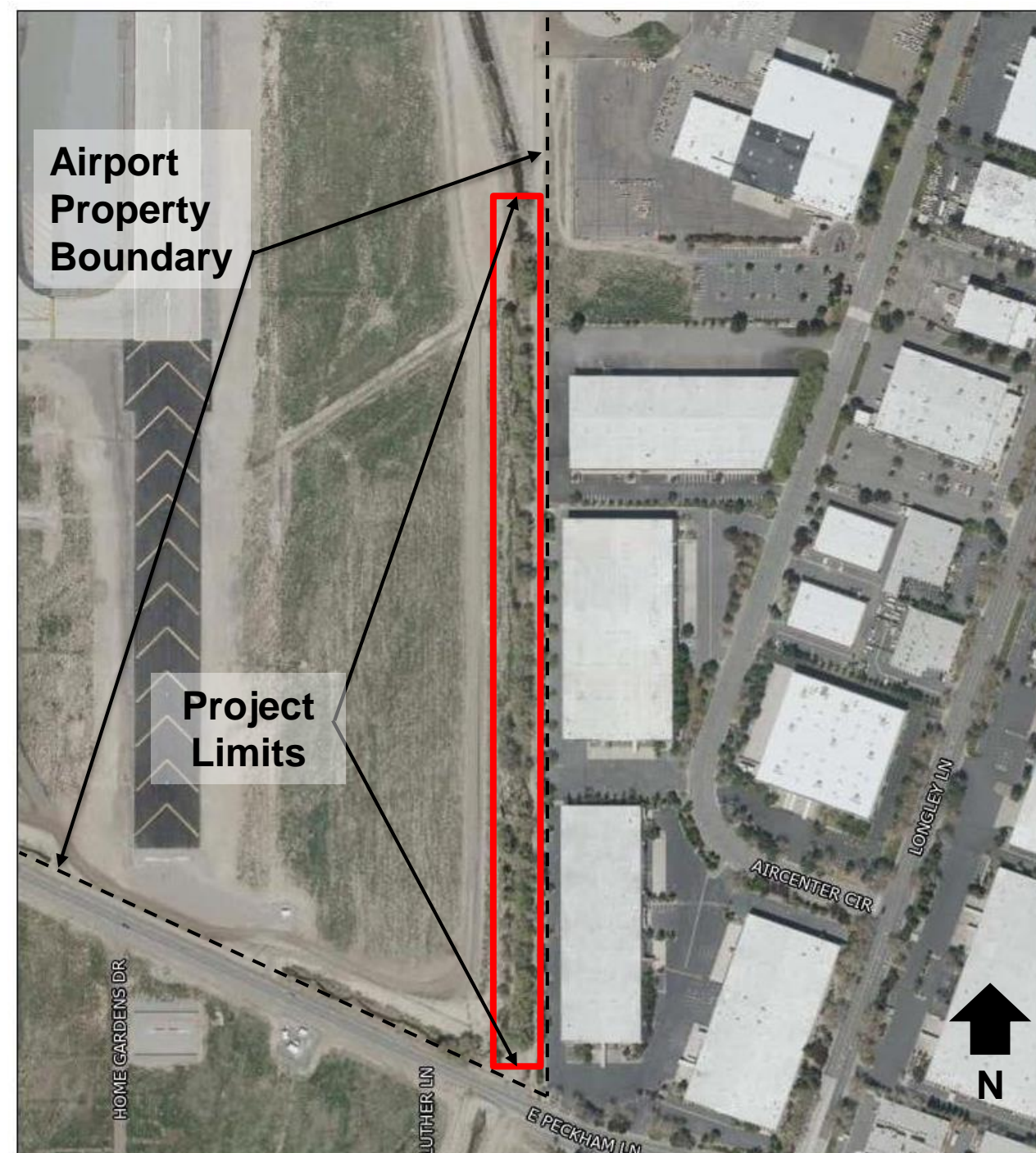
Dry Creek channel stabilization within the Reno Tahoe International Airport

1900 linear feet of channel stabilization from Peckham Lane proceeding north





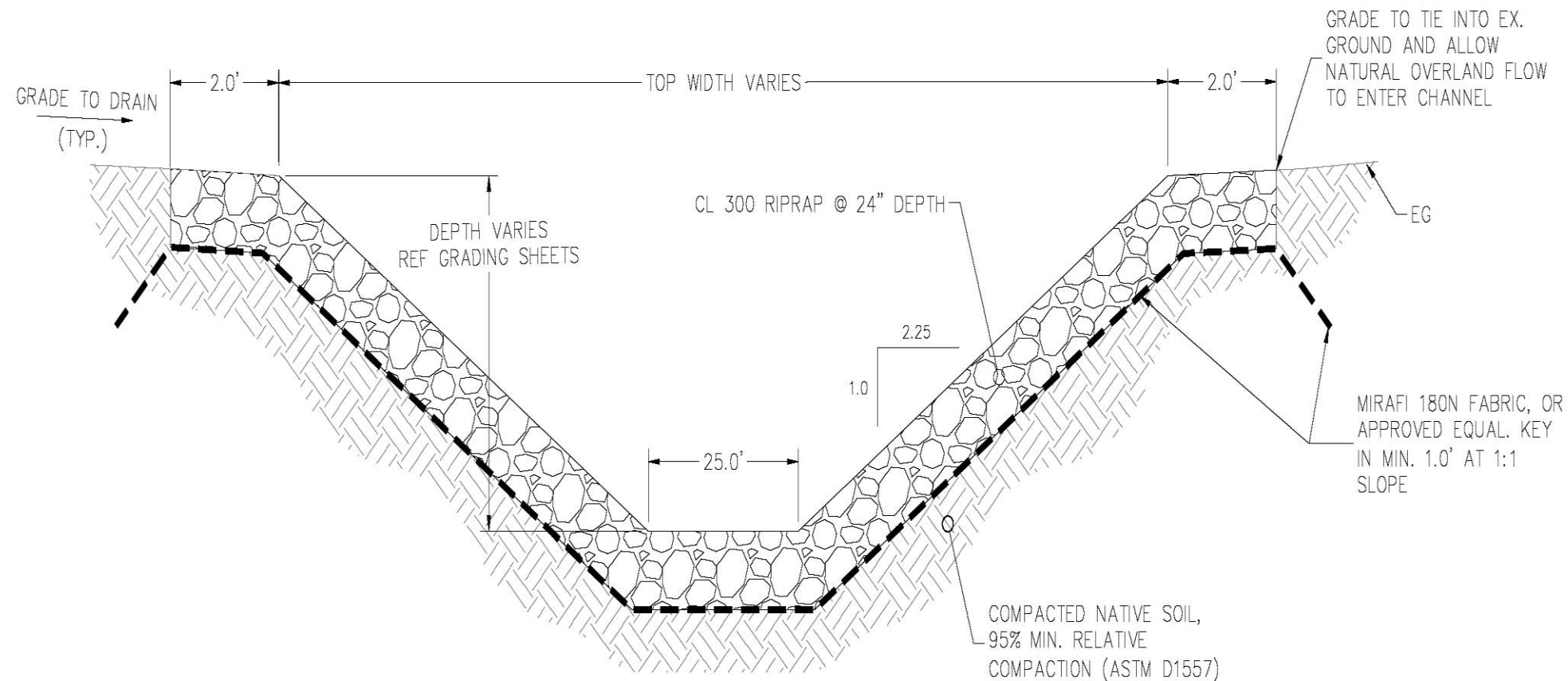
# Project Overview

Dry Creek

with riprap





## Why It's Recommended

- City of Reno is responsible for maintaining this section of Dry Creek by way of easement
- Channel banks will continue to erode and migrate into adjacent parcels without the installation of riprap
- Reno Tahoe Airport AOA fencing must be protected
- Water quality benefit by stopping ongoing erosion

Item B.09 – I move to award the contract to Granite Construction Company for the Dry Creek Restoration Project in the amount of \$4,713,463.
