Reno BDR Process

Gather Ideas and Conduct Preliminary Research

January - July 2022

Discuss Options and Select BDRs

July - August 2022

Submit to Legislative Counsel

September 1, 2022

Adopt City of Reno Legislative Policy Platform prior to Legislative Session
