

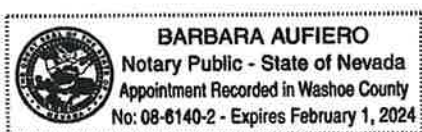



As a fifth generation Nevadan, my ties to Reno run deep. My great grandparents built a home in the Powning Addition on Jones Street in 1936 while working at the Winter Street Garage. My grandfather built a local law practice with the late senator C. Clifton Young while my other grandfather made a post-navy career helping Nevada ranchers as UNR faculty. I grew up in the Nevada outdoors hiking and holding survey rods for my father. As a local engineer, he reshaped mining waste rock into revegetated mountains and designed Reno infrastructure. I was that kid with a poster size photo of the construction project that completed the McCarran loop. By high school I bored my friends with details about western states water rights fights and the pros and cons of municipal debt financing. I am an alum of Reno High, TMCC, and UNR and when I bought my first house it was in Ward 5 on East 8th Street.

I love this city and want to work for our residents. In that work, I'll apply my deep community ties and breadth of skills. Those skills, refined through sport, international mental health research, entrepreneurship, community advocacy, and business management, will anchor a listen first and seek collaborative outcomes approach to representing the interests and working for opportunities for both Ward 5 and the city of Reno.
