Summary:

There will be one vacancy on the Regional E911 Advisory Board as of April 30, 2023. The Clerk's Office has received one application from Andrew (Andy) Ancho, Reno Fire Department Division Chief of Emergency Management.

Reno Fire Department Division Chief of Support Services, Jeff Voskamp's appointment is set to expire on April 30, 2023, which will leave one City of Reno vacancy.

The City Clerk's Office received the recommendation to appoint Andrew (Andy) Ancho, Reno Fire Department Division Chief of Emergency Management, to fill this vacancy as a designee for the term of May 1, 2023 through June 30, 2026.

Background:

The County Ordinance establishes three City of Reno appointees to the E911 Advisory Board, but it requires in accordance with SB 176 (2017 Session) as codified in NRS 244A.7645 that the advisory committee must:

(a) Consist of not less than five members who: (1) Are residents of the county; (2) Possess knowledge concerning telephone systems for reporting emergencies; and (3) Are not

elected public officers.

(b) Subject to the provisions of subparagraph (3) of paragraph (a), include the chief law enforcement officer or his or her designee from each office of the county sheriff, metropolitan police department, police department of an incorporated city within the county and department, division or municipal court of a city or town that employs marshals within the county, as applicable.
