Summary:

There are currently four vacancies on the Building Enterprise Fund Advisory Committee (BEFAC). Teresa Di Loreto's appointment expired on March 31, 2023, Ms. Di Loreto is eligible for and interested in reappointment.

The term of appointment is for the period May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2027.

Background:

Pursuant to NRS 354.59893, the governing body is to appoint a minimum of five members (the City has seven members) to the Building Enterprise Fund Advisory Committee (BEFAC) for a term of at least two years but not to exceed four years. The governing body or its designee may

renew the term of any member of the committee.

Resolution No. 8838 states the City shall appoint up to seven members from the Reno community building industry representing a cross-section of the industry including residential, commercial and industrial. Members may also include a public officer or employee of the local government who manages the fiscal affairs of the local government and a public officer or employee of the local government who oversees directly the operation of the enterprise fund. Up to two members may be from the general public.
