Summary: There is currently one vacancy on the Access Advisory Committee (ACC). The Clerk's Office has received applications from Nickolas Camit, LaShon Colter, Tracy Kimmons, Dora Martinez, and Lucas Stephenson. The term of all vacant appointments is for the period August 1, 2022 through July 30, 2025.

Alignment with Strategic Plan: Not applicable.

Previous Council Action: There is no recent Council action relevant to this item.

Discussion: The Access Advisory Committee (ACC) consists of nine members and shall include disabled persons and persons interested in issues involving disabled individuals. Committee members are to be appointed by Council. The term of membership is three years and members shall not serve more than two terms. Pursuant to RMC 2.08.880, the ACC may submit a list of potential members to Council for appointment to fill a

vacancy. Appointments to vacancies other than expiration of a term shall be for the remainder of the term and filled within 30 days of the vacancy.

Financial Implications: None at this time.

Legal Implications: Legal review completed for compliance with City procedures and Nevada open meeting law.

Recommendation: Staff recommends Council make the necessary appointment to the Access Advisory Committee.
