**Summary:** Vice Mayor Devon Reese would like to allocate \$1,000 from Council Discretionary Funds assigned for FY 22/23 to Baby's Bounty, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization in support of their mission to support and empower at risk families by providing education and the essential tools to ensure a good start for every baby. Discretionary funds are allocated to each Council member each fiscal year to be used to help support the initiatives of local 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations. Staff recommends approval of the resolution to donate these funds.

**Previous Council Action:** There is no recent Council action relevant to this item.

**Financial Implications:** Funds are budgeted for Council Discretionary in the General Fund.

**Legal Implications:** Legal review completed for compliance with City procedures and Nevada law. NRS 268.028(1) states that the governing body of a city may make donations to nonprofit organizations created for religious, charitable or educational purposes to be used for a selected purpose. The donated funds must be used to provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city. Council approval is required before the recommended funds transfer can take place. Legal review completed for compliance with City procedures and Nevada law.
