Summary: Councilmember Naomi Duerr would like to allocate \$1,000 from Council Discretionary Funds assigned for FY 22/23 to Envirolution Inc., a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization in support of their mission to inspire and empower the next generation of leaders and workers who will drive the growth of a sustainable economy. Discretionary funds are allocated to each Council member each fiscal year to be used to help support the initiatives of local 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations.

Alignment with Strategic Plan: Infrastructure, Climate Change, and Environmental Sustainability

Previous Council Action:

Financial Implications: Funds are budgeted for Council Discretionary in the General Fund.

Legal Implications: Legal review completed for compliance with City procedures and Nevada law. NRS 268.028(1) states that the governing body of a city may make donations to nonprofit organizations created for religious, charitable or educational purposes to be used for a selected purpose. The donated funds must be used to provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city. Council approval is required before the recommended funds transfer can take place.
