Legal review completed for compliance with City procedures and Nevada law. The donated funds must be used to provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city. Council approval is required before the recommended funds transfer can take place.

RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO HENRY’S HOUSE IN SUPPORT OF THEIR MISSION TO PROVIDE A SAFE HAVEN FOR NEGLECTED, ABANDONED, OR UNWANTED SENIOR AND SPECIAL NEEDS SMALL BREED DOGS IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$2,000. [SCHIEVE] (GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Henry’s House strives to provide care for all dogs that find their way to Henry’s House until a forever home is found; and,

WHEREAS, Henry’s House seeks to reduce the number of abandoned senior animals through proper education of spay/neuter practices and proactive outreach; and,

WHEREAS, Henry’s House relies on support from the community to be able to provide the necessary care to the senior and special needs dogs under their care; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Mayor Schieve in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to Henry’s House; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
